Winter Conference Move from spring successful

Participation was down only slightly at the Annual SISPA Conference held Feb. 23 resulting in a decision to have the 2006 Conference held on the corresponding date of Thursday, Feb. 23, 2006.

The Conference, normally held in the spring, was moved to February to avoid conflicts with other high school activities.

After consultation with attending advisors this year, the winter format was retained. While wenther is a consideration, conflicting schedules and cartier school dismissals have necessitated the winter date.

Participation in the 2005 55th Annual Conference was similar to last year. Fourteen schools, representing 17 staffs were in attendance. The 243 attending students were registered as 149 yearbook students and 94 newspaper.

Again, the on-site contests were popular with 127 students enrolled, 52% of those at the conference.

Seven students participated in the Senior Interview of Mike Reis, Saluki basketball announcer.

The Newspaper Workshop and Yearbook Workshops were also received well, although tweaking needs to be done. Alternative sessions will also be offered next year.

Schools attending the Conference were Greenville HS, Cisne HS, Belleville West Township HS, Herrin HS, Mater Dei HS-Evansville, Springfield HS, Columbia HS, Hamilton HS, Wayne City HS, Newton HS, Harrisburg HS, Coulterville HS, Carlyle HS and West Frankfort HS.

"The on-site contests continue to be the main draw to the Conference," Herman Albers, said. "We've aligned the contests to coincide with the IHSA Journalism contests that will begin in 2006. But we also will continue to offer other sessions to get more schools and students involved at the 2006 Conference."
